Being an allotment holder is a major commitment on people's time and the Royal Horticultural Society suggest that a full plot requires eight hours of maintenance each week. This will be less in the winter months, but there will still be tasks to complete. We really want our members to make a success of their membership and enjoy the experience. If you have little gardening experience it might be better to take on a smaller plot to see how you get on. You could subsequently consider taking on a second half plot subject to availability. If you know an existing plotholder you might consider joining as their associate while waiting for a plot. This will give you a chance to find out more about our society and just what is involved.

I understand that in making this application it is my responsibility to keep these contact details up to date and that when a plot becomes available, I must reply within fourteen days accepting the offer. I understand that my membership would be initially for a six-month probationary period and that I would have to ensure that at least 50% of my plot is under cultivation or turned over ready for cultivation at all times. I understand that the plot would have to be used throughout the year and not just for the summer months.
